After Hours Incident Reporting Procedure for Individuals, Families and Community Members:

After 4:30 p.m. weekdays, weekends and all non-work days, individuals, families or community members may report an incident affecting the health and safety of a Delaware County Board of Developmental Disabilities (DCBDD) eligible child or adult by contacting

Helpline at (800) 684-2324.

The Helpline operator will contact the DCBDD On-Call Support Administrator who will call you back to take the report and/or provide assistance as appropriate.

When and What to Report:

ALWAYS BETTER TO OVER REPORT THEN TO NOT REPORT AT ALL!

- Examples of incidents may include but not be limited the following:
- -Death
- -Abuse, neglect or misappropriation
- -Law enforcement involvement
- -Media involvement
- -Incidents that involve immediate health and safety issues
- -Individual can not be located for a period that causes a concern for health and safety
- -Injury of unknown or suspicious origin
