**Kathy VanBuskirk Outstanding Service Award**

The Kathy VanBuskirk Outstanding Service Award was created by the Association for the Developmentally Disabled and Delaware County Developmental Disabilities in honor of Kathy and her dedication to providing exceptional services to individuals with developmental disabilities. The award was designed to recognize a direct care provider annually who is dedicated and reliable, advocates for persons with developmental disabilities, and who treats individuals with respect, dignity, and full recognition of their equality as fellow citizens.
