RE: Early Intervention and the Core Team Primary Service Provider Approach

Dear Early Intervention Providers,

Delaware County Board of Developmental Disabilities (DCBDD) is now accepting Informal Requests of Interest (ROI) for our Early Intervention Core Team Primary Service Providers. DCBDD has been in practice under this model of service delivery since September 1, 2017.

We are seeking speech therapists, occupational therapists, and physical therapists to join core teams. The teams will work with service coordinators and developmental specialists from DCBDD to provide services to children with developmental disabilities in Delaware County from birth through two years old.

Therapists will be contracted for up to 40 hours weekly and will be compensated at \$65.00 per hour. Trainings will be required and will be paid at \$65.00 per hour for each therapist.

In order to be considered for the Core Team, therapists must:

- Have a flexible schedule:
- Be willing to work in a designated area per team in Delaware County;
- Participate in mandatory trainings;
- Be willing to implement program requirements;
- Attend weekly core team meetings, Individualized Family Service Plan meetings, Contract Management meetings;
- Provide documentation of LLC or Agency status
- Accept the contracted rate of \$65.00 per hour.
