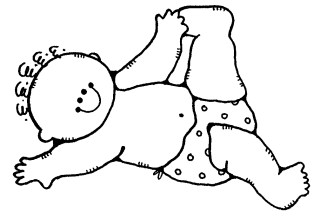

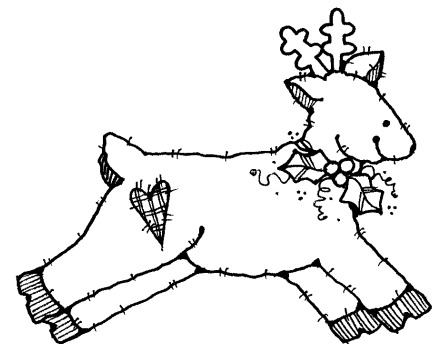

Elimination of loud or sudden sounds

Elimination of abrupt changes in lighting

and freedom of movement

Limited seat sales for guests with spatial issues

Quiet lobby area for breaks

Communication cards for non-verbal guests

Sensory Friendly Resource packages for families

Safe, friendly, and judgment-free environment
