Request for Proposal For Strategic Planning Facilitation

The Delaware County Board of Developmental Disabilities (DCBDD) is requesting proposals for strategic planning facilitation services to guide the development and implementation of our next three year plan. The purpose of this three year plan is to enhance the services and support we provide to our community.

DCBDD is a county agency that provides support to more than 2,300 people with developmental disabilities and their families in Delaware County. Our core support is provided through Early Intervention (support for children ages birth thru two) and Service and Support Administration (support for people ages three and older). In addition to these core focus areas, DCBDD has been increasingly involved in community wide efforts that create inclusion for all people.

As Delaware County grows, so does the need for DCBDD services. Currently, 77% of the people who receive support from DCBDD are under the age of 22. Over the next five years, more than 150 children will transition to adulthood. Understanding our current needs and plan for future growth is paramount in developing our next strategic plan.

We are seeking a partner to assist in developing an innovative strategic plan that supports our vision that all people will lead personally fulfilling lives.
