- be a certified as a provider and have proof of completed annual training requirements
- be one of the following:
 - state-licensed psychologist
 - o state-licensed professional clinical counselor
 - o state-licensed professional counselor
 - o state-licensed independent social worker
 - state-licensed social worker working under the supervision of a licensed independent social worker or certified Ohio behavior analyst
- have experience in
 - o completing risk assessments
 - o functional behavioral analysis
 - o implementing positive behavior strategies
 - o implementing restrictions that are temporary in nature
 - o working under the rules of the Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD);
- participate in mandatory trainings
- be willing to implement program requirements
- provide documentation of LLC, Agency with Choice, or Agency status (pending DCBDD Board approval)

Interested applicants are asked to submit the following: proof of certification, licensure and insurance, hourly rate for service, and the completed questionnaire to Mike.Dancho@dcbdd.org no later than August 31, 2022.
